



TOTAL ECLIPSE: The total eclipse of this past Monday, if you were living in the right area, can remind us that our world is much larger than we may habitually think on a daily basis.

But nature can pull us out of ourselves and remind us of the cosmic Christ. St. John's Gospel begins with these words: "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was

with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things came to be through him, and without him nothing came to be."

I appreciate that the eclipse coincidentally came during the Easter season when are conscious of new life. We see it popping forth in nature in many ways. Someone wrote: "We have an invitation to go to church in a new way, by praying before the new leaves budding through dormant trees or the wobbly flowers by the side of the road pushing through the solid earth... [Like Francis of Assisi,] we too can sing with the air we breathe, the sun that shines upon us, the rain that pours down to water the earth."

In our pains and the daily hurts that life also offers us, my world can become quite small. Let us let Christ arise in us and rejoice in the new life popping forth everywhere. And I will add: especially in the new life of our parish: those being baptized, confirmed, making their First Communion and those entering into marriage. "These are the days the Lord has made: Let us be glad and rejoice. Alleluia."

## FUNDING A CATHOLIC EDUCATION



#### **PARISH SUBSIDY**

It costs approximately \$11,000 to educate each student. St. Francis Xavier Parish provides a generous subsidy to keep tuition more affordable for families.



St. Francis Xavier offers generous discounts for multiple children in grades K - 12. Check the registration packet for details.





#### **ACE SCHOLARSHIPS**

ACE Scholarships are solely income-based, partial-tuition scholarships. Scholarship amounts are usually \$2000-\$3000. It is available to incoming PreK, kindergarten, and students transferring from public school. Visit the ACE website for more information. www.acescholarships.org/become-a-scholar/kansas/



529 Plans allow tax-free earnings growth and tax-free withdrawals for qualified expenses. Qualified expenses include up to \$10,000 toward K-12 private school tuition. 529 plans also offer an additional deduction on KS income tax. Low-income families may qualify for KIDS matching grant contributions. Visit kansascash.ks.gov/learn\_quest.html





#### COVERDELL EDUCATION SAVINGS ACCOUNT

Similar to a 529 Account, Coverdell accounts allow tax-free withdrawals to cover all educational expenses such as supplies and uniforms. However, contributions are capped at \$2000 a year per beneficiary, and there are some income restrictions on who can open an account.

#### CHILDCARE TAX CREDIT

PreK Tuition qualifies for Child and Dependant Care Federal Tax Credit. www.irs.gov/credits-deductions/individuals/child-and-dependent-care-credit-information





#### OTHER SCHOLARSHIPS

The Salina diocese offers a scholarship for students who qualify for free and reduced lunches. Amount varies based on number of applicants per year. salinadiocese.org/office/catholic-schools/a-scholarship-opportunity/
