Here is a mock-up of one of the stained glass windows that will go into the Gathering Space Wall. It is an image of a lion. We will have 4 images of saints and 4 images of the symbols of the Evangelists (Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John). The lion represents Mark. His Gospel is the shortest and the most direct. Mark starts his Gospel with the roar of St. John the Baptist in the desert and ends it with the apostles preaching the saving message everywhere! This image will be colored and shaded. Question: I see that you promote Eucharistic Adoration all the time. What do I do during adoration?

Answer: "No longer do I call you servants...but I have called you friends (John 15:15)." If you want to be a good friend with someone, you have to spend time with them. Adoration is your opportunity to spend time with the best friend of your life. It need not be complicated. Take these words spoken by Christ to a priest in 2011.

"When you come to pray, it is not so much the words that matter; it is your loving attention to My presence that consoles my Heart. Give me your attention, and I will work the wonders of My merciful love in your soul. Hold yourself facing Me. Abide in My presence gently without forcing yourself to produce thoughts, feelings, or sensations. none of these things is necessary to a prayer that pleases Me and gives Me the freedom to act in a soul."

In another entry, Christ says, "The practice of adoration is not difficult. It is a gentle abiding in My presence, a resting in the radiance of my Eucharistic Face, a closeness to my Eucharistic Heart. Words, though sometimes helpful, are not necessary, nor are thoughts. What I seek from one who would adore Me in spirit and in truth is a heart aflame with love, a heart content to abide in My presence, silent and still, engaged only in the act of loving Me and of receiving My love (In Sinu Jesu, p. 200 and 208)."

Do not complicate your relationship with Christ. Come and give Him your problems, your weakness, your weariness, your joys, and fears! He just wants you to spend time with Him. Do you want the same?

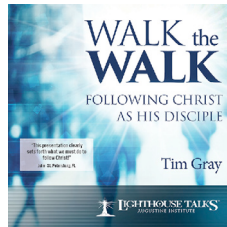
