

Service Hour Guidelines

Service Hours are a requirement of St.

Francis Xavier School and Confirmation classes for the successful completion of each grade. **Five** hours a quarter are expected from all St. Francis Xavier students who are in 7th-12th grade, & the 8th and 9th grade confirmation classes. This accumulates to **20** hours per school year. These hours are **required**. They must be completed August 2018 through May 2019. If students desire to complete service hours over the course of the summer, previous permission will be required. Please take note that *altar serving* will no longer be listed as a service project; this being said, we still absolutely encourage students to serve for both school and weekend Masses. For Confirmation students who also attend St. Francis Xavier school, **20 hours are expected total**, accumulative.

Service hours will be monitored and facilitated by the Director of Stewardship. Fr. Kyle, Mr. Augustine, and Heidi will be in charge of signing for service hours completed.

The phrase 'service hours' refers to your stewardship to the parish; specifically as students through your time and talent.

St. Francis Xavier Parish and School - Opportunities will be posted in the bulletin, the parish website, facebook, Oneparish, or fliers.

The three ways you can fulfill your 'service hours' through the parish are: 1) participating in parish-sponsored service projects, 2) participating in school-sponsored service projects, or 3) receiving prior permission from the Director of Stewardship to serve for a different organization.

Mark your calendars for **October 6th** to help with the parish-wide clean-up. This event will offer 5 service hours.
