





*- This amount is determined by the Parish Finance Council. It is based on the annual cost of Parish operations for the parish year, 01 Jul thru 30 Jun. The annual cost includes items such as the maintenance for our buildings, utilities, all Mass and church supplies, salaries for staff, support for the school...everything right down to the Kleenex provided in the church. The annual amount is then divided by the 12 months in a year to establish the monthly amount necessary. The tithing collections offered by our parishioners each week, our only income, is reported in the spirit of transparency for all. When we fall short in our collections for the needed monthly operating expenses, the difference must be pulled from investments or savings to cover the operating expenses. This impairs our sustainability to 'grow' our parish programs and services in the future.

Note: The new fiscal year's monthly operations budget amount will be updated next week.

Don't forget to teach our children how to submit their envelopes weekly! Take one with you to fill out for the following weekend if that is of help instead fixing one on the way into Mass.

I begin with giving big Thank You to Fr. Gnansekar Kulandai. If you have ever had the opportunity to watch the two of us with each other, you would easily see how much we enjoy each other. He is a very kind, intelligent, holy man with a good sense of humor. I am grateful for all he gave to our diocese, to me and to this parish. We are all much better because of his ten years in the diocese.

His presence can remind us that the Church in the United States has never been able to exist with just native priests. We have always benefitted from "Missionary Priests." I find this a humbling thought for us as we like to think of ourselves as giving to the world. Our US church does in many ways but we receive so much as well. Some in this parish will remember that the pastor of St. Francis Xavier parish from 1955 to 1982 was Msgr Thomas Keogan. He was from Ireland (definitely!!!) along with several others from Ireland serving in the diocese in his time.

We need to continue to pray for vocations, as we do before Mass. We also need to pray about lay ministry – in its many forms. Our diocese works in conjunction with the Dodge City diocese to offer lay ministry courses in the Pastoral Ministry program. These opportunities will be made known in the coming weeks.

Again, thank you for the wonderful welcome you gave to Fr. Gnansekar and to me. My first weekend was very uplifting for myself, Deacon Ed and Mary. May God continue to bless all of us. Father Kerry

THE SOUND OF FREEDOM: a movie featured locally and in Manhattan. It tells the story of Operation Underground Railroad which exists to rescue children from trafficking and exploitation. It is highly recommended by our diocese. A bit more info about the man behind the scene:

ABOUT TIM BALLARD

Tim Ballard spent more than a decade working as a Special Agent for the Department of Homeland Security, where he was assigned to the Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force and deployed as an undercover operative for the U.S. Child Sex Tourism Jump Team.

He has worked in that role and since in every type of case in the fight to dismantle child trafficking rings. He's worked in the United States and in multiple foreign countries to infiltrate child trafficking organizations. He has successfully dismantled dozens of these organizations and rescued children from slavery and exploitation.

While working for the government, Ballard saw how much more is needed in the fight against child trafficking and exploitation across the world. In 2013, he and a team of former government operatives left the security of their careers to accomplish the work of rescuing children as a private foundation - Operation Underground Railroad. At O.U.R., Tim has created a team that can work in any jurisdiction and in conjunction with law enforcement to rescue children directly. That team exists today and operates all over the world.
