

*- This amount is determined by the Parish Finance Council. It is based on the annual cost of Parish operations for the parish year, 01 Jul thru 30 Jun. The annual cost includes items such as the maintenance for our buildings, utilities, all Mass and church supplies, salaries for staff, support for the school...everything right down to the Kleenex provided in the church. The annual amount is then divided by the 12 months in a year to establish the monthly amount necessary. The tithing collections offered by our parishioners each week, our only income, is reported in the spirit of transparency for all. When we fall short in our collections for the needed monthly operating expenses, the difference must be pulled from investments or savings to cover the operating expenses. This impairs our sustainability to 'grow' our parish programs and services in the future.

Note: The new fiscal year's monthly operations budget amount will be updated next week.

Don't forget to teach our children how to submit their envelopes weekly! Take one with you to fill out for the following weekend if that is of help instead fixing one on the way into Mass.

LITURGY

We gather each week "to do liturgy." What is liturgy? The word comes from the Greek and literally means "work." For example, a farmer's liturgy is farming, a housewife's liturgy is the work of the home, etc.

Our "liturgy" when we gather each Sunday is to do Eucharist. That word means to give thanks. That should not be a surprise considering that the beginning of the Eucharistic Prayer is the dialog: "Let us give thanks to the Lord our God......It is right and just.....It is truly right and just....to give thanks..."

We do that individually and communally. That is why liturgy contains so much dialog. We each contribute so that the total result is more than any one of us individually. The result is that the faith of each person can build as they participate.

In my first two weeks, I have been very pleased with the participation both vocally and in singing. From where I am, when I pause and listen, I truly sense we are giving thanks to God. All of this reminds me of a real truth that I see coming together: "each of us is very important and yet not that important." A thought worth contemplating!!!!!




