

* - This amount is determined by the Parish Finance Council. It is based on the annual cost of Parish operations for the parish year, 01 Jul thru 30 Jun. The annual cost includes items such as the maintenance for our buildings, utilities, all Mass and church supplies, salaries for staff, support for the school...everything right down to the Kleenex provided in the church. The annual amount is then divided by the 12 months in a year to establish the monthly amount necessary. The tithing collections offered by our parishioners each week, our only income, is reported in the spirit of transparency for all. When we fall short in our collections for the needed monthly operating expenses, the difference must be pulled from investments or savings to cover the operating expenses. This impairs our sustainability to 'grow' our parish programs and services in the future.

Don't forget to teach our children how to submit their envelopes weekly! Take one with you to fill out for the following weekend if that is of help instead fixing one on the way into Mass.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Fr. Kerry Ninemire

"JESUS WEPT" Jn 11:35, the shortest verse in the Bible. And even though so short, so powerful. "The One through whom and by whom all things were made and without whom nothing was made (Jn 1:3), that powerful and awesome God wept. His emotional burst comes after he comes to the grave of Lazurus, one of his best friends, and sees there his friends, Martha and Mary, crying. Like us so often in a similar situation, he cannot help himself. He feels deeply. He knows the value of friendship and he hurts so deeply to see them hurt.

Another time Jesus cries is when he arrives on a hill overlooking Jerusalem, knowing that he will enter and they will not listen to him, the Bible says in Luke 19: 41-42, "He wept over it." He so wants what is best for them and for us. I know each of us can feel that pain as well at times with those we love and we seem them entering a path that will lead to more pain.

These two incidents help us appreciate the humanness of Jesus. We can too quickly and too easily stress his divinity, which is definitely there. But first, Jesus' tears tell me that our first response to tough and sad situations should not be to try to fix, to soothe, to remove the pain. Often, it is just okay to enter into it, to feel it. Just as only then Jesus moved on, then for us as well, it is only then time to try to begin to move on. I find it easier to entering into the pain knowing that he enters with me, with us.

May God bless us all. Father Kerry


