

Due to the early bulletin submissions, the tithing totals will be update in Oct. Please notice that as of the 17 Sep collections, we are still in need of \$50,166.27 to meet our operating expenses for the month of September.

Amount needed to meet our Sep 2023 Parish operating budget (new amount for 23-24 FY) \$87,632.50 \* Sep Tithing and Offering collections to date \$37,466.23 \$50,166.27 Balance needed to meet our Sep needs:

Sep 2023 G&D collected to date .....\$4,386.35

\* - This amount is determined by the Parish Finance Council. It is based on the annual cost of Parish operations for the parish year, 01 Jul thru 30 Jun. The annual cost includes items such as the maintenance for our buildings. utilities, all Mass and church supplies, salaries for staff, support for the school...everything right down to the Kleenex provided in the church. The annual amount is then divided by the 12 months in a year to establish the monthly amount necessary. The tithing collections offered by our parishioners each week, our only income, is reported in the spirit of transparency for all. When we fall short in our collections for the needed monthly operating expenses, the difference must be pulled from investments or savings to cover the operating expenses. This impairs our sustainability to 'grow' our parish programs and services in the future.

Don't forget to teach our children how to submit their envelopes weekly! Take one with you to fill out for the following weekend if that is of help instead fixing one on the way into Mass.

October begins with prayers for the unborn and the rally on October 1. Please join in Sunday, October 1 from 2-3 pm to stand up for Life! Let us all do our part to defend preborn babies!






### WHAT IS #IGIVECATHOLIC?



September is stewardship month in our Catholic faith. Need a way to give back to God for your many blessings...volunteer to help with our liturgies!

Your parish family needs Altar Servers, Lectors, Ushers, Extraordinary Ministers and folks to bring the gifts of our parish to the altar in celebration of the Mass. These stewardship ministries are very simple and you are going to be at Mass weekly anyway, right? Participating in these ministries won't take you any more time and there are no dues involved. Sound attractive...keep reading!

So, you want to know what is involved? Here are the details:

- 1. Once a month you will respond via email to those who schedule these ministries as to your availability so that the schedule for all can be prepared.
- 2. Attend the training for each ministry on how Father would like to have them done in accordance with Canon Law. This is a one-time training with refreshers as liturgical requirements change.
- 3. When life happens and you are unable to meet your assigned time and function, find a substitute and let the ministry lead know of the change.
