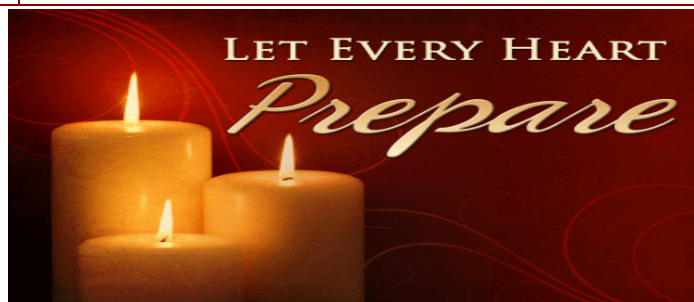

### A NEW YEAR, A DIFFERENT GOSPEL:

The readings from Scripture that we hear proclaimed each Sunday are divided into a three-year cycle. The idea is that if you come to Mass each weekend over this time one will hear almost all of the Bible in this three-year time frame. How does one keep track? If the year is divisible by three (e.g. 2022), then one begins year A in December or the First Sunday of Advent that year.

We have just finished Year A and in it the focus was on the Gospel of Matthew. In 2023-2024, Year B, we will listen to the Gospel of St Mark for the most part. His Gospel is short and so it will be supplemented by the Gospel of John in the middle. We will hear from chapter 6 of St. John's Gospel which focuses on Jesus as the Bread of Life. This is especially appropriate this coming year as our universal church is focusing on our Lord's presence in the Holy Eucharist.

St Mark's Gospel was written to a community suffering persecution. His emphasis is Jesus remaining steadfast in the face of opposition. His passion narrative is longer than the other evangelist's version while the actual Gospel is much shorter, sometimes called an introduction to the Passion. As we hear his Gospel, let us pray for the grace of endurance, steadfastness and hope in the midst of our own sufferings.

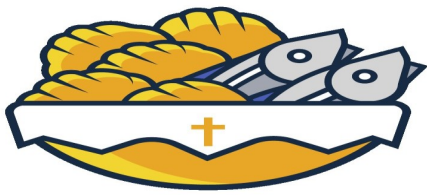


**SAINT FRANCES XAVIER DAY CELEBRATION**

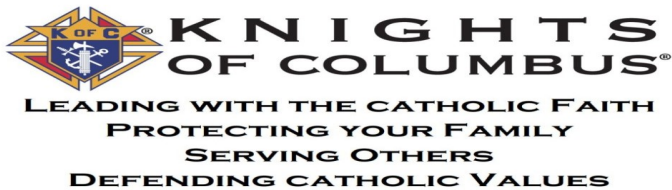

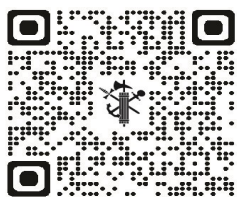
