


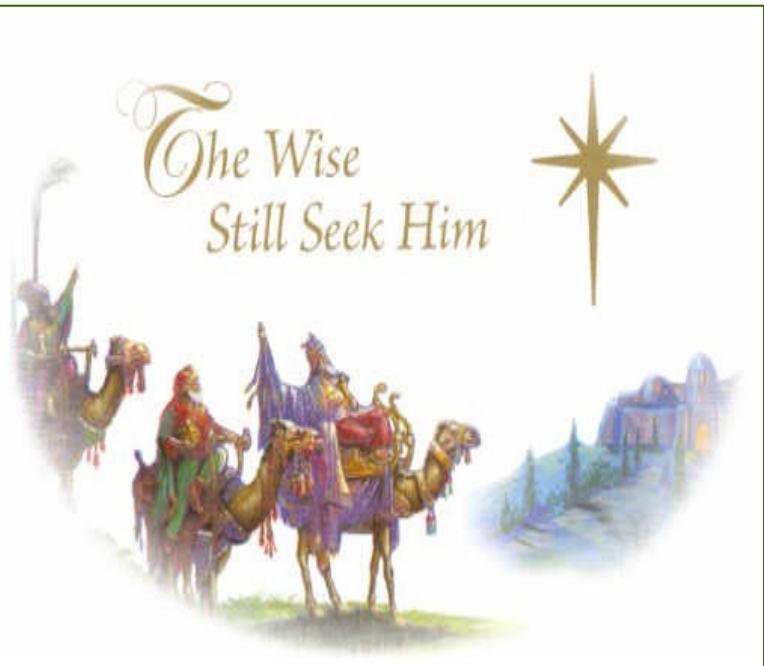
**PRAYER FOR THE SICK**

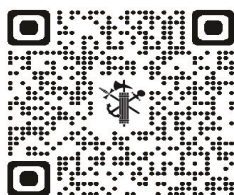
