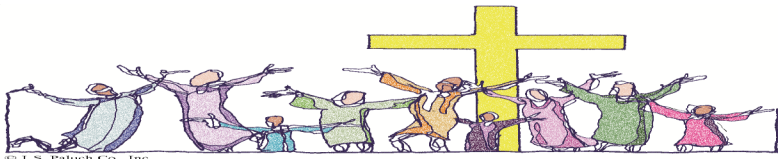

RICE BOWLS: Rice Bowls are a wonderful complete way to live out the Lenten tasks of fasting, prayer and almsgiving. The idea is to place the Rice Bowl on your dining table and choose one meal per week to eat less. The money saved is placed in the bowl and a prayer is said for those receiving the gift. We ask that you bring the bowls with the money to Holy Thursday: on the night we remember Christ washing the feet of his apostles, we wash the feet of the poor with our gifts. One-third of the money remains in the diocese to benefit food banks and two-thirds is given to world-wide Catholic Relief Services.

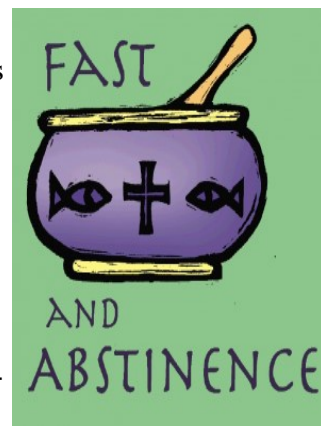

How do we fast?

When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

Am I excused from fasting and abstinence?

Those that are excused from fast and abstinence outside the age limits include the physically or mentally ill including individuals suffering from chronic illnesses such as diabetes. Also excluded are pregnant or nursing women.

concessions, and don't miss the cheer clinic performance at the halftime of the game. Hope to see you there!

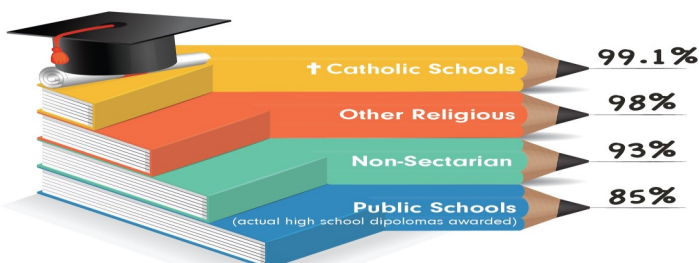

A look at national high school graduation rates.



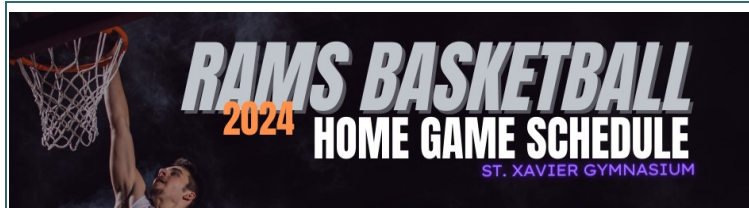

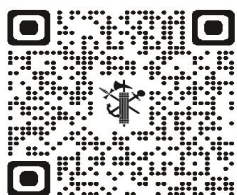
